ROMANS 12:17-21 "Do not repay anyone evil for evil ... Do not take revenge, but leave room for God's wrath, for it is written: "It is mine to avenge; I will repay," ... On the contrary: If your enemy is hungry, feed him; if he is thirsty, give him something to drink... do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good."

PSALM 143:8-12 "Let the morning bring me word of your unfailing love, for I have put my trust in You. Show me the way I should go, for to you I lift up my soul. Rescue me from my enemies, O Lord, for I hide myself in You ... silence my enemies; destroy all my foes, for I am your servant."

I CORINTHIANS 13:4-7 "Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth (love thinks no evil but always offers grace). It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. (does not give up in anger)"

JAMES 1:5 "If any of you lacks wisdom, she should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault and it will be given to her."

PSALM 51:10 "Create in him and me a pure heart."

PSALM 51:17 "Give him a broken and contrite heart."

ROMANS 12:12 "Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer."

I CORINTHIANS 16:13,14 "Be on your guard, stand firm in the faith; be (a woman) of courage; be strong. Do everything in love."

Bear with each other and forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another. Forgive as the Lord forgave you ... let the peace of Christ rule in your heart."

PSALM 138:7,8 "Though I walk in the midst of trouble, You preserve my life. The Lord will fulfill his purpose for me; Your love, O Lord, endures forever."
