

# Guidance in Times of Darkness and Lawlessness

## - ANGER -

<b>Ephesians 4:26</b>	And “don’t sin by letting anger control you.” Don’t let the sun go down while you are still angry, (NLT)
<b>Ephesians 4:17-19</b>	With the Lord’s authority I say this: Live no longer as the ungodly do, for they are hopelessly confused. Their minds are full of darkness; they are far from the life God gives because they have shut their minds and hardened their hearts against him. They don’t care anymore about right and wrong and they have given themselves over to immoral ways. Their lives are filled with all kinds of impurity and greed. (NLT)
<b>2 Corinthians 10:1</b>	...with the gentleness and kindness that Christ Himself would use... (NLT)

## - CONFUSION -

<b>2 Timothy 4:3-4</b>	For the time will come when they will not tolerate sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, will multiply teachers for themselves because they have an itch to hear something new. They will turn away from hearing the truth and will turn aside to myths. (HCSB)
<b>Colossians 2:8</b>	Be careful that no one takes you captive through philosophy and empty deceit based on human tradition, based on the elemental forces of the world, and not based on Christ. (HCSB)
<b>2 John 1:9</b>	Anyone who wanders away from this teaching has no relationship with God. But anyone who remains in the teaching of Christ has a relationship with both the Father and the Son. (NLT)
<b>James 1:5</b>	If you need wisdom, ask our generous God, and he will give it to you. He will not rebuke you for asking. (NLT)
<b>1 Thessalonians 5:22</b>	Stay away from every kind of evil. (NLT)

## - GUILT -

<b>Psalms 79:8</b>	Do not hold against us the sins of past generations may your mercy come quickly to meet us, for we are in desperate need. (NIV)
<b>John 1:29</b>	The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, “Look! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world! (NLT)
<b>Hebrews 10:22</b>	Let us go right into the presence of God with sincere hearts fully trusting him. For our guilty consciences have been sprinkled with Christ’s blood to make us clean, and our bodies have been washed with pure water. (NLT)
<b>Galatians 5:1, 6</b>	Christ has liberated us to be free. Stand firm then and don’t submit again to a yoke of slavery...For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision accomplishes anything; what matters is FAITH working through love. (HCSB)
