hroughout the Bible, you'll find praises to God, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit. Praise is POWERFUL in prayer.

What does "Praise" mean?

Praise means to tell God how great He is! It's bragging on God.

What does "Praise" sound like?

Praise always begins with something similar to this,

"God I praise You. You are the Mighty Creator. You are good and kind."

OR

"I worship You, God."



Why is spending time praising God important?

The Bible says God draws close to us when we begin loving Him with our words of praise to Him. (Psalm 22:3)

God wants us to know Him and be in relationship with Him. Praise helps us learn more about Him. The more we learn about Him, the more our relationship with Him can develop.

TOOLS FOR PRAISE:

- The Holy Spirit Ask the Holy Spirit to lead your worship!
- Music- Use the words to hymns or praise music. Yes, sing to God. God loves to hear you sing.
